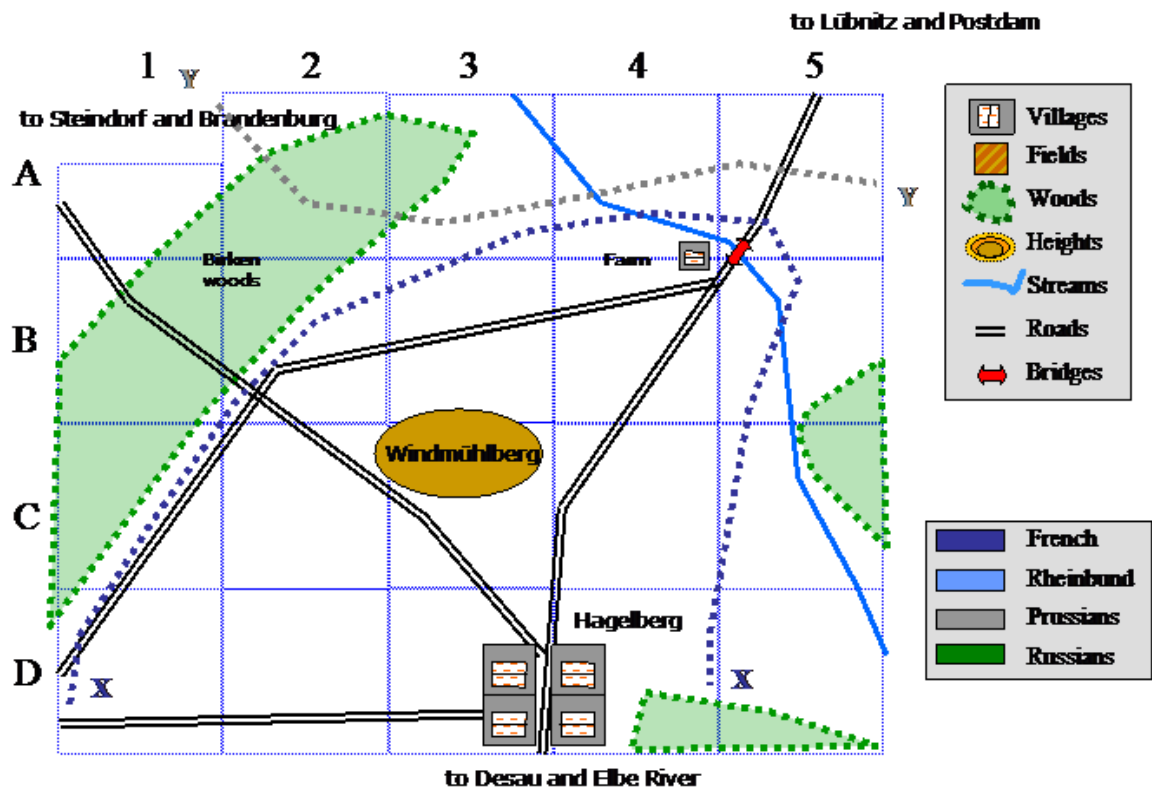


The Battle of Hageberg. August 27, 1813

This battle was fought between the French Girard's Garrison or Division) of Magdeburg and the Prussian Hirschfeld corps. The goal of Girard's force (3rd battalions and some Rheinbund battalions) was to join Oudinot in the advance towards Gross-Beeren whereas the Hirschfeld force (comprised by Reserve, Landwher and Cossacks) was posted to the right wing of the Army of the North (Bernadotte's own) to cover its flank and, precisely, watch the Magdeburg Garrison. The order of battle and maps are adapted from the Nafziger's book 'Napoleon at Dresden. The battles of August 1813' (see Bibliography).
