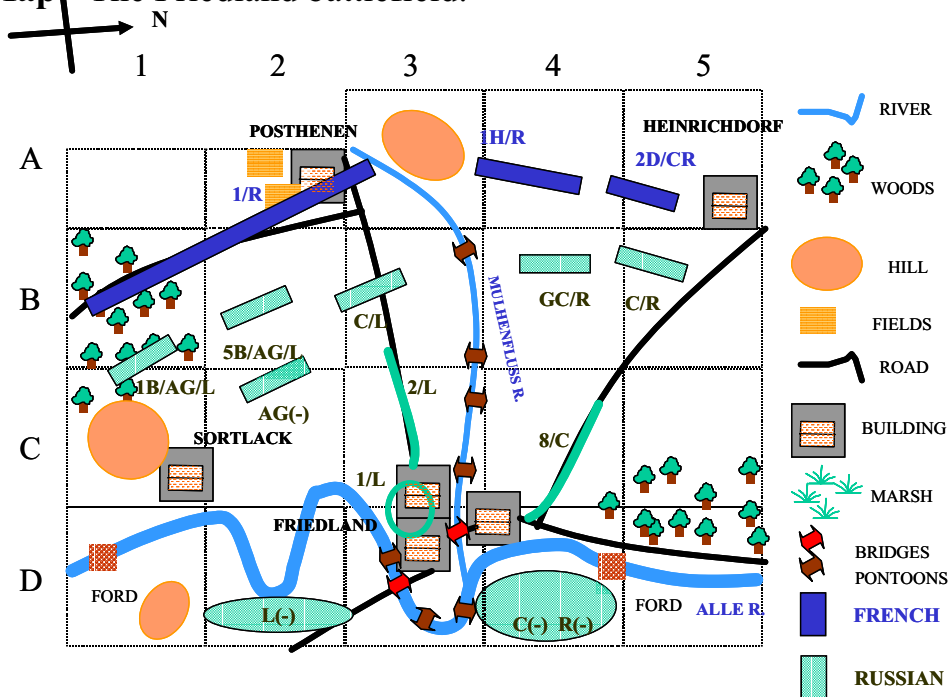


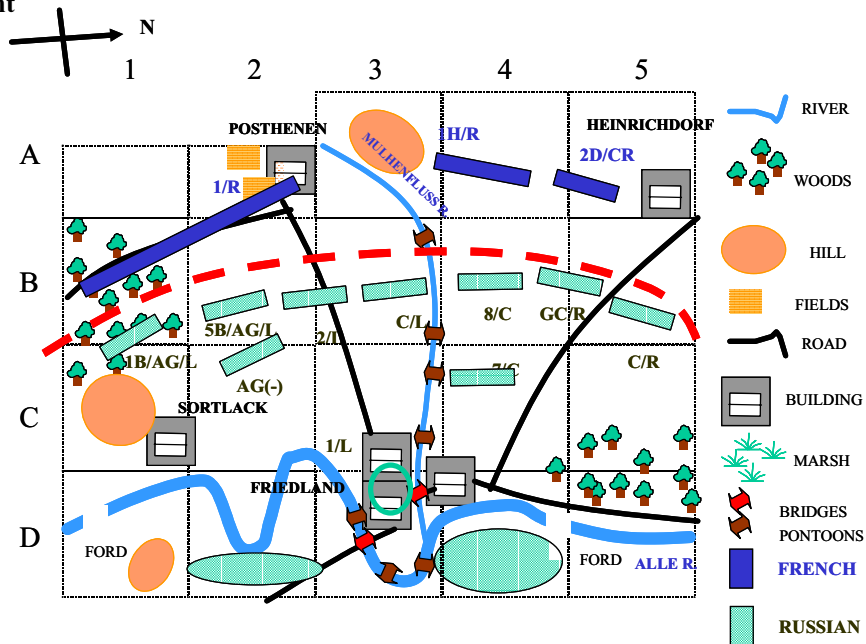
# Scenario 10.1: The Battle of Friedland June 14, 1807

The battle of Friedland is the final battle of the spring 1807 campaign

## 10.1.1 Map: The Friedland battlefield.



### Second Variant



### Map Notes (The squares are 40x40 sq. cm or 1.3x1.3 sq. ft)

**10.1.1.1:** All the buildings have a +1 combat modifier. The river Aller is fordable only in the north and south fords. These fords may be used only by units in column, limbered or march column formations. The Muhlenfluss is unfordable from Postthenen to Friedland. Bridges with a road are permanent, others are temporary.

**10.1.1.2.:** Lannes and Grouchy and the commanders of the on-table divisions are the only French generals that start the game on the tabletop. The French reserve Corps 4# battery is set-up with the 1/R division

**10.1.1.3:** All Russian generals and forces start set-up on the tabletop. One C/L #6 battery is set-up with the 1B/AG/L unit, and the other battery of that division with the AG/L (-) unit. The 2/L and the 8/C divisions must set-up in continuous march columns on the roads, as shown on the map. The French on-table forces are set-up first. In the second variant use the red line to divide the battlefield.

## 10.1.2 Friedland Orders of Battle

### 10.1.4.1- Game length

5.00– 19.30 hours (30 turns). The Russians are the first side

### 10.1.4.3. Lannes

Prior to the arrival of Napoleon (12.00 hours) Lannes is considered to be the French supreme commander and can be considered to have a response number of 10

### 10.1.4.4a. Short Scenario Variant

The game is played only from 05.00 to 11.30 hours (14 turns). (See the victory conditions and free rolls) Otherwise when playing the entire scenario, if the Russian side wins (a quick win) under the conditions of the short scenario, they have won the entire battle (the French, after their drubbing, do not seriously continue the battle with their additional forces), which then ends with the 11.30 hours turn.

### 10.1.4.4b. Second Scenario Variant

The game is played from 10.00 hours onwards (24 turns). All French reinforcements must be diced out, as if the game was played from 0.500 a.m., using the optional Scenario rule on arrival time. The French units are placed in their side of the Mulhenfluss (according to their entry point). Follow the order of arrival (and the military common sense) for their placement. The victory conditions and free rolls are the same than in the entire scenario

### 10.1.4.5. Russian Crossings

**10.1.4.5 .1** The locations of the Alle River fords were unknown to both sides until located by the Russians during their retreat at the end of the battle. Therefore, these fords may only be found after 15.00 hours by moving an un-routed cavalry or infantry unit to a ford location. Then, during the side's Rally step, one die (per ford) may be rolled: 1-4 means a ford is discovered (for the rest of the battle) and may be used for crossing the river. A higher roll means that a ford has not been found for that Turn (later attempts may be made).

**10.1.4.5 .2:** The three westernmost temporary bridges (the three first counting from above in the map) over the Muhlenfluss are not completed and may not be crossed until 10.00 hours. Alternately, if desired, use the optional construction rules and give the Russians 3 engineer units for use in construction

### 10.1.4.6. Optional

The French start with the initiative, but it may not be used until Napoleon enters the tabletop. The French have 10 free rolls and the Russians have 8 free rolls. If only the short scenario variant is played, no one has the initiative, the French have 6 free rolls and the Russians 4 free rolls.

## 10.1.5 Victory Points

**10.1.5.1 Entire scenario:** The buildings of Friedland are worth 20/38 each, the buildings of Heinrichsdorf and Sortlack are worth 40/78 each, Posthenen is worth 155/295, the permanent bridge over the Muhlenfluss is worth 140/266 and the permanent bridge over the Alle is worth 180/342 in French/Russian victory points. All objectives, except the buildings of Heinrichsdorf and Posthenen, which are considered to be French-controlled, are considered to be Russian-controlled at the game's start

**10.1.5.1 Short scenario:** For a quick win, the Russian side must have at least 5.1 times the total victory points of the French side at the end of the 11.30 hours turn.

## NOTES

- a** For infantry in square, use the other (OT) modifier if vs. any infantry. For infantry not in square, use the “OT” modifier if vs. any attacking cavalry, and not in a town, entrenched, or with friendly cavalry in the same combat. For attacking cavalry, use the “OT” modifier vs. infantry or artillery not in square and not in a town, entrenched, or with friendly cavalry in the same combat. Use the current modifier in all other combats.
- b** The “RSP (Response) number is used for cavalry recalls (with a “-1” modifier for Austrian HC and LC , a “-4” for British (not KGL) and “-2” for all other cavalry), rallying and for square (with a “+1” for Prussian GD, GN and LN in line formation until 1809, “+2” for Austrian GN and LN in column formation after 1807, and “+1” for all other infantry in column formation. General RSP modifiers are: “-1” if Poor, “+1” if Good and “+2” if Excellent. The disorder modifier is “-3”. A modified RSP number is also the withdrawal modifier.
- c** **ROUTES** Infantry and gunners 46 cm, cavalry and limbered artillery 69 cm. Routing units always in column or limbered
- d** Subtract for the “LIN or UNL” speed. Also the cost to “about face”. Cannot used while within 3 cm of an enemy unit
- e** Eliminated on “1-3” when alone or attached to a routed, dispersed or eliminated unit
- f** Use the current formation modifier
- g** May evade infantry (horse artillery limbers, if not so when contacted) unless disordered or routed. Only reacting cavalry may evade enemy cavalry
- h** May dismount
- i** Same as when mounted
- j** Can all-out attack Number = army morale value
- k** Two fire hits from one shoot or One combat hit are required to eliminate an artillery, pack train or wagon crew figure (also disorders the unit). Any artillery, pack train or wagon is eliminated with two eliminated crew
- l** Use a “-1” modifier for artillery representing only 4-5 guns. Gunners without their gun lose their ability to fire
- m** Per 4 cavalry or infantry bases or per 1 artillery, pack train or wagon base. 1 point less for batteries of only 4-5 guns
- n** 10-12 gun batteries (usually Russian) are represented by two separate artillery bases
- p** May not initiate combats
- q** May initiate combats only if attached to infantry or cavalry
- r** Rout number is +1 with 6 or more bases
- s** Is skirmish infantry
- \* Does not count for army moral
